

# Chevron Colour-Block Blanket



#### Finished measurements

48" x 60"

# Yarn

Cascade Eco Cloud (150 m - 165 yds, 70% Merino Wool, 30% Baby Alpaca)

4 skeins 1810 – (Colour A)

4 skeins 1806 – (Colour B)

2 skeins 1801 – (Colour C)

2 skeins 1809 – (Colour D)

## Needles

7mm / US 10.75 knitting needles – or size needed to obtain gauge

## Tension / gauge

16 sts in 4" / 10cm Stockinette stitch

## **Pattern Repeat**

Pattern repeat is 32 stitches

#### **Abbreviations**

 $\mathbf{k} = \text{knit}$ 

yo = yarn over

**k2tog** = knit two stitches together

**ssk** = slip, slip, knit. Slip two stitches separately as if to knit, then place the left needle into the fronts of these two stitches and knit them together

**md** = mitered decrease (slip 2 sts tog as if to k2tog, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over.



#### **Pattern**

With colour A cast on 193 stitches.

## Row 1 (RS) and all right side rows:

k1, ssk, k13, yo, (k1, yo, k14, md, k14, yo) repeat brackets until 17 sts remain, k1, yo, k13, k2tog, k1

# Row 2 (WS) and all wrong side rows:

purl all stitches, purl yo's through the back loop

Repeat rows 1 and 2 for the entire blanket working each colour block for 10" (approximately 44 rows) in the following manner:

Colour A

Colour B

Colour C

Colour D

Colour B

Colour A

Cast off loosely, sew in ends, and block. Enjoy!
